Orchids of Mexico

Jim Rose, Cal-Orchid, will present an overview of the orchids of Mexico, their care and culture. On his extensive travels, Jim has hiked the Mexican wilderness to observe orchid growing conditions. His talk blends in 45 years of commercial orchid growing experience. Jim is a walking encyclopedia of everything related to orchids. You don't want to miss this meeting.

After UC Santa Barbara as an anthropology major, Jim, in 1971, began working at the Santa Barbara Orchid Estate where he met his wife, Lauris. In 1987, Jim and Lauris purchased a 2-acre cymbidium nursery which they transformed into an internationally known orchid nursery providing one of the largest varieties of orchid species and hybrids in the United States.

***Cal-Orchids** maintains an active breeding program and stud collection built upon decades of international travel. Cal-Orchids is the premier supplier of lycaste in the US. Jim and Lauris are recognized for their superior "Pacific" line of reed-stem Epidendrums.*

Jim has been published in AOS Orchids, Orchid Digest, CSA. He is respected for his encyclopedic knowledge. His lectures have been featured at orchid events in North America, Japan, Europe and the last World Orchid Conference in South Africa.

Jim is a Cymbidium Society of America Judge, past member of AOS Conservation Committee. He's on the Japan Grand Prix Organizing committee & judges annually at the Tokyo Dome.
