Unifoliate Cattleya

Carol Klonowski's talk on the History of Unifoliate Cattleyas explores the discovery, cultivation, and popularization of labiata-type cattleyas starting from the jungles of Central and South America through the floral industry trade and finally as their popularity has re-emerged in recent years. Aside from Phalaenopsis, no other orchid comes to mind as quickly when someone mentions the words 'orchid flower', and the culture information from the talk can easily apply to most other orchid genera.

Carol Klonowski has been growing orchids since the 1980's when a friend gave her a cattleya that bloomed out with three big, fragrant, dark lavender flowers. She built an entire greenhouse in her backyard to accommodate the precious plant, which only led her to buy more orchids. Another friend gave her a gift membership to the Orchid Society of California, and it's been a serious hobby and passion ever since. Carol has served as Director, VP, and President of the Orchid Society of California and is a Fully Accredited AOS Judge with the Sierra Nevada Judging Center.
